

**ORDINANCE NO. 24-58** - Being an Ordinance authorizing the City Manager to enter into a five (5) year single-hauler agreement (with four (4) renewal years in one (1) year increments) with Kimble Recycling & Disposal, Inc. for the residential solid waste, recyclables, yard waste, and annual curbside spring clean-up for collection and disposal of residential solid waste and recycling.

WHEREAS, the City of Louisville received three (3) bids for collection and disposal of residential solid waste and recycling, in accordance with bidding requirements; and

WHEREAS, the three (3) received bids were opened on September 10, 2024, and addendums to the bids were opened on September 19, 2024 with Kimble Recycling & Disposal, Inc. (“Kimble”), determined to be the lowest and best bidder; and

WHEREAS, the proposal includes pricing for Kimble to serve as the single-hauler provider for collection and disposal of residential solid waste services, with the option to add on recycling, and further allows for up to ten percent (10%) of residents to elect to opt-out of said services; and

WHEREAS, the proposal will reduce costs for all residents receiving residential solid waste and recycling services.

NOW, THEREFORE THE COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF LOUISVILLE, STATE OF OHIO, HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section One: The City Manager, upon approval of the Law Director, is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an Agreement, attached as “Exhibit A,” with Kimble for the collection and disposal of residential solid waste and recycling in the City.

Section Two: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
