The 200 car parking lot provides space for visitors to enjoy the vast amenities this park has to offer. The largest pavilion, featuring a fireplace and electricity, is a favorite rental space for larger gatherings.

The Louisville community built the "Magical Rainbow Playground" which provides hours of fun for youngsters.

The Park also includes soccer fields, picnic areas, a dog park, and miles of biking, walking, and running paths. Each path has mileage markers for the convenience of all fitness levels.
