MINUTES OF THE OCTOBER 7, 2019 REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING

Mayor-Council Member Fallot declared the minutes of the October 7, 2019 Regular Council meeting approved as presented.

RESOLUTION NO. 19-45 – BEING A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE AMOUNTS AND RATES AS DETERMINED BY THE BUDGET COMMISSION AND AUTHORIZING THE NECESSARY TAX LEVIES AND CERTIFYING THEM TO THE COUNTY AUDITOR

City Manager Larry Collins reported that this weekend is Halloween Fest and the Brewery should be having their grand opening. The Library Board voted unanimously to allow the use of the green space for the ice skating rink.

Planning & Development Director Vince Marion reported that he is waiting for the final information from Redwood before construction can begin.

Fire Chief Rod Bordner had nothing to report.

Police Chief Andy Turowski thanked those who attended the active shooter event.

Service Director Dan Millsap reported that the West Main Street Waterline Project should be completed in the next few weeks and that he will address the holes in the intersection.

Mayor-Council Member Fallot reported that she attended the 90th Anniversary of Biery Cheese at the MAPS Museum to present them with a proclamation.
